

## **1. Respect for JAMA Global's Campus & Facilities**

Please treat all buildings, grounds, and equipment with care.

Only enter areas designated for alumni events.

Follow any posted signs and all instructions from JAMA staff.

Clean up after meals, snacks, and activities. Let's leave the campus better than we find it.

Anyone that decides to cross into territory that no longer belongs to JAMA will deal with JAMA leadership, authorities and new property owners.

## **2. Honor One Another**

Use uplifting, Christlike speech.

Be mindful of sensitive or divisive topics (politics, arguments, gossip).

Welcome and include others—especially those attending alone or after many years away.

Show grace and patience; everyone is coming from different seasons of life.

## **3. Protect the Atmosphere of Fellowship**

This reunion is meant to be safe, joyful, and God-honoring.

Please avoid disruptive or disrespectful behavior.

Keep volume reasonable in shared or quiet spaces.

Approach every interaction with kindness, humility, and love.

#### **4. Photography & Videos**

Photos and videos are welcome!

Please ask permission before taking close-up or identifiable pictures of individuals, especially children.

Use discernment when posting on social media—avoid sharing private moments or anything that could embarrass someone.

#### **5. Parking & Transportation**

Park only in designated lots or areas approved by the event team.

Follow any traffic flow instructions and shuttle guidelines if available.

Do not block walkways, fire lanes, or emergency access roads.

#### **6. Food & Drink**

Please enjoy food only in approved dining spaces.

Clean up your area after meals and snacks.

Follow any posted guidelines regarding outside food or campus restrictions.

#### **7. Children & Youth Guidelines**

Designated Childcare Provided

Approved childcare will be available during scheduled reunion activities (final times will be announced).

Only authorized volunteers or staff will supervise children in these spaces.

Check-In / Check-Out Procedures

A parent or legal guardian must check each child in and out.

Children may only be released to the person who checked them in unless pre-authorized.

Please arrive promptly for pickup.

#### When Children Are Not in Childcare

Children must remain with their parent/guardian if they are not checked into childcare.

Wandering the campus unsupervised is not permitted.

#### Campus Boundaries

Children must stay in event-approved areas only.

Restricted spaces (staff-only buildings, dorms, prayer rooms, and non-event classrooms) may not be entered without permission.

#### Behavior & Respect

Children should behave respectfully toward the campus and property.

Disruptive or destructive behavior may require immediate parent contact or pickup.

#### Health & Safety

Inform childcare staff of allergies, medical needs, or special instructions.

If a child becomes ill, injured, or distressed, a parent will be contacted immediately.

If you're not feeling well, please rest at your lodging for the safety of others.

Report any spills, injuries, or safety issues to the event team as soon as possible.

Keep personal belongings secure.

Larger gatherings or group meals may have set start times; please follow the posted schedule for those.
